

# FAMILY ADVOCACY MINISTRY

### YOUR CHURCH CAN SERVE MORE CHILDREN AND FAMILIES **THROUGH FAMS**

Offering support to vulnerable children and those caring for them. **Did you** know that there are over 7,600 vulnerable children in the foster care system in NYC alone?

#### Family Advocacy Ministry (FAM) was

launched in connection to our 10 Zip *Codes Project* working through our ethos of collective impact to engage collaboration within NYC's most vulnerable neighborhoods. FAMs help provide what vulnerable children need most- strong families, LEAD.NYC equips churches to create FAMs to meet real-time needs that can change lives when foster families, adoptive or biological families are in crisis. FAMs can prevent kids from entering foster care. intervene once foster care is a

necessity, and/or connect children with families for a lifetime. We do this through two pathways:

### **1. CAREPORTAL TOOL**

**CarePortal**, is an online technology platform that brings the needs of vulnerable children and families in vour community to your attention. CarePortal creates connections within the circles of Care around the isolated child. A few examples of needs are beds. cribs. car seats. clothes. school supplies, mentorship, and transportation.

#### How does CarePortal work?

Requests submitted through CarePortal come from caseworkers at government child welfare agencies or other childserving organizations approved by CarePortal to vet needs. Caseworkers uncover the needs, and CarePortal makes local churches and community members aware, giving them real-time opportunities to respond.



### 2. CARE COMMUNITIES TOOL

In partnership with **Promise 686**, FAM trains churches to create and maintain volunteer-led Care Communities that provide a strong support system for foster and adoptive families. Volunteers offer support in the following ways: *bringing weekly meals, supplying, or sourcing practical needs, transporting children to appointments, mentoring children, coordinating volunteers to serve a family and more!* 

#### Why Care Communities?

Parents who foster or adopt need to know they'll be well-supported when a child arrives in their home. Children in foster care, as well as adopted children, have unique needs, and require intentional focus from their new parents. Supporting these families in practical, hands-on ways provides a healthier context for a child's transition into their new home.

# **10 ZIP CODES PROJECT**

### COLLECTIVE IMPACT MAPPING IN EAST HARLEM, WASHINGTON HEIGHTS, EAST NEW YORK & STATEN ISLAND

As part of The 10 Zip Codes Project, the Neighborhoods Team completed an asset mapping report to get a snapshot of the collective faith communities' social impact in neighborhoods throughout the last 16 months of COVID-19. The neighborhoods of East Harlem, Washington Heights & Inwood, East New York & Stapleton/ Park Hill (Staten Island) were surveyed. The data and stories demonstrate the genius, ingenuity, adaptability, and effectiveness of the church and faithbased organizations during one of the most disruptive and traumatic seasons of recent history. It also presents a huge opportunity, with many needs still to be met and many churches and organizations wanting to do more to love their neighbor.

Key results include:

- 49% of organizations increased their social impact activities in response to COVID-19, despite churches closing.
- 67% of organizations' work includes serving vulnerable children or youth
- \$9,562,230 social impact value to New York City (from church volunteer hours & staff hours to the neighborhood, not including goods and other resources.)
